JOB ROLE

As an E&I Technician you will improve plant availability through root cause analysis of instrument and electrical equipment faults and implementation of appropriate remedial action.

You will carry out preventative and corrective maintenance tasks, including fault finding, to resolve and eliminate equipment problems and malfunctions, ensuring that engineering documentation associated with electrical and instrumentation systems are kept up to date, including operational manuals, procedures, electrical drawings, P&IDs, loop diagrams, alarm and trip procedures etc. You will be able to identify and implement opportunities for engineering improvements to enhance the manufacturing availability and capability of the plant assets.

The role will support the implementation and commissioning of minor plant improvement projects so that improvements are implemented and handed over in a safe manner.

Working knowledge of ATEX and associated BS EN standards associated with equipment installed in a hazardous area and current edition IEE wiring regulations (BS7671) fault finding and problem-solving skills.
